



Bangor Township's Green Team Expo & Spring Clean Up Day

WHAT: Bangor Township will be hosting a clean up day to allow Township residential properties to dispose of trash and other waste materials at the Township Administration Building. Acceptable items include most household waste, tires, mixed metals, paper and plastic.

WHO: This event is limited to residential property owners who participate in the Township's trash special assessment. Picture identification is required.

WHEN: **Saturday, April 21, 2018**
10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

WHERE: Bangor Township Administration Building Parking Lot
180 State Park Drive



HOW: Interested Bangor residents are asked to contact the Township at (989) 684-8931 with any questions and to pre-register their waste to insure proper staffing and waste receptacles are on hand to serve you.

Acceptable Items

- Furniture (tables, chairs, sofas, beds, etc.)
- Appliances (washers, dryers, stoves, etc.)
- Refrigerators & Freezers (see below for requirements)
- Car tires (limit 10) & rims – separated
- Heating/Cooling Equipment w/ CFC removed
- Computer Equipment
- Sewing Machines
- Televisions
- Hot water tanks
- Yard Furniture
- Pool sides/liners
- Tires

All Freon containing devices, must be certified and labeled Freon free by a licensed contractor for acceptance

Items NOT Accepted

- Large car parts or batteries
- Construction/demolition material or railroad ties
- Yard waste materials
- Concrete
- Any liquids
- Flammables
- Pesticides
- Explosives
- Pool Chemicals
- Poisons

Many of the items that are unacceptable on Township Clean Up Day can be disposed of at Bay County's Annual Household Hazardous Waste event. Information regarding this event can be obtained by calling the Bay County Health Department at 895-4006 for date and location or any additional information.
