Public Works Committee
August 10, 2017
10:00 a.m.**

PRESENT: Glenn Rowley, Karie Wardynski, Rich Phelps, Matthew Dubs from Wade Trim

K. Wardynski called the meeting to order at 10:07 a.m.

Moved by R. Phelps, supported by G. Rowley, to approve the July 27, 2017 committee minutes as presented. Motion carried – All in favor.

The Department of Water and Sewer was replacing piping on Two Mile Road near Fisher. This included road restoration after the pipe was replaced. They contacted Bangor and Monitor Township about resurfacing the remaining 120 feet of road not affected by the pipe replacement. They needed an immediate decision. The Township Board approved this project. The DPW discussed the project and the Board's decision. Moved by G. Rowley, supported by R. Phelps, to ratify the Bangor Township Board's approval of the project. Motion carried – All in favor.

G. Rowley distributed an email with a cost estimate from Shaw Contracting on replacing the meter pit near the Bangor Rail Trail Bathroom. The estimate was much higher than expected at \$4,500.00. Bay Community Foundation offered to pay half of the repair bill; however, the Township cannot justify the remaining expense in this year's budget, especially since the bathroom would be closed for the season soon anyway. M. Dubs reviewed the estimate and said with the amount of work to be done, the estimate seems reasonable. The DPW decided to keep the bathroom closed for now as other options are explored.

Updates from M. Dubs included the Pine Road Title Search, which should be done soon, and that he is working on a solidified estimate for the Wenona Project.

Being no further business, the Department of Public Works Committee Meeting adjourned at 10:20 a.m.
