PRESENT: Glenn Rowley, Karie Wardynski, Rich Phelps, Matthew Dubs and Jason Kenyon from Wade Trim, Jim Lillo from the Bay County Road Commission

K. Wardynski called the meeting to order at 2:05 p.m.

Moved by G. Rowley, supported by R. Phelps, to approve the September 11, 2017 committee minutes as presented. Motion carried – All in favor.

Wheeler Road is being redone by the Road Commission next year. M. Brown discussed replacing the blue saddles at that time since many would need to be replaced in the near future anyway. Several have already been replaced so he was not sure on the number still remaining. This project would be similar to the Lauria Road Project. If we can get the information about which saddles need to be replaced, we can bid out the project this winter. J. Lillo is willing to coordinate the road project with our saddle replacement project. We might be able to split project up into phases if we can't do it all at once. It would be beneficial for the Township and the Road Commission to use the same contractor. M. Dubs will try to get the number of saddles that need to be replaced.

The Township needs to meet with the City again on the Wenona Project. M. Dubs is working on the proposal for the project.

Pine Road title work is coming in slowly. We are also still waiting on the permit from the DEQ. Wade-Trim is drafting easement language and will send to the Township attorney for review. They will also give us a new timeline for getting the project done.

A resident has been circulating a petition for a drainage project near Devonshire and Greenbriar. An estimate from nearly 2 years ago has the cost at over \$1,000,000. There are 100 homes in the subdivision so it would break down to roughly \$500 per year for 20 years for each parcel. J. Lillo stated that Glendora, Darla, Alvarado, and Altadena might just need to be cleaned out. He will make sure any root balls are cleared out.

Being no further business, the Department of Public Works Committee Meeting adjourned at 2:47 p.m.
