PRESENT: Glenn Rowley, Rich Phelps, Karie Wardynski, Matthew Dubbs from Wade Trim, Mike Brown from Bay County Department of Water & Sewer

K. Wardynski called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

Moved by G. Rowley, supported by R. Phelps, to approve the October 4, 2016 committee minutes as presented. Motion carried.

Discussion took place regarding the sewer project on Pine Road. The line will not need to loop back around, but M. Dubbs is going to check on current line size to ensure it is large enough. K. Wardynski double checked with the MTA on use of Sewer Funds for road replacement. They confirmed that sewer funds could only be used to replace the part of the road torn up for the sewer project; nothing else. M. Brown will look at the size of the current water line and determine need for replacement while sewer lines are being installed. Moved by G. Rowley, supported by Rich Phelps, to recommend the Pine Road Project to the Board to set up the Hearing of Necessity.

M. Dubbs started a discussion on a question previously posed by G. Rowley about sewer connections at the end of Wilder Road. There is a 15 inch sewer main out to the railroad tracks and a 3 inch forced flow line beyond that. Still unsure if SC Johnson is tied into the Sewer.

Shirwinjo Drive could not be completed as part of the John Street Project. The easement could not be secured from the Foxes. This part of the project was just to loop the sewer back around. Not a priority at this time.

M. Dubbs discussed a potential project to finish off work previously done on Jenny and Gies. G. Rowley mentioned that Thomas and Jenny might be repaved as part of the City Beautification project. The Township will wait to see if the City is going to redo those roads and possibly coordinate with them if they move forward with that project.

M. Brown stated that the project at the top of his list right now is replacing lead pipes. Normally pipes are only replaced to property line. If there are lead pipes, might have to replace all the way up to the house. G. Rowley asked M. Brown to gather info on any lead pipes in Bangor Township and bring to next DPW meeting.

M. Brown will also reprioritize water main project list.

Lagoon Beach Road was discussed as a road project. M. Brown will check for lead lines there and report back.

Timing of the next DPW meeting was discussed. K. Wardynski will start coordinating the next meeting the second week in March, after Tax Settlement.
